

Minutes of T11.1 HIPPI Ad Hoc Working Group

October 10, 2001

San Diego, CA

1.0 Opening remarks and introductions

The T11.1 Chairman, Roger Ronald of VIEO, opened this meeting at 9 AM and thanked Craig Stuber and JNI for hosting this meeting.

This group is constituted as both the HIPPI Working Group under T11.1, and the High Performance Networking Forum (HNF) - Technical Committee (TC).

Roger lead a round of introductions. The list of attendees is at the end of these minutes. Roger volunteered to produce these minutes.

2.0 Review / modify the draft agenda

Draft agendas were distributed via the www.hippi.org web site before the meeting.

It was noted that SCSI over ST comments would not be addressed due to the absence of Don Woelz.

These minutes reflect the approved agenda.

3.0 Document Distribution

Roger described the HIPPI web page at www.hippi.org. Meeting documents are placed there and people are encouraged to pick up the documents before the meeting as extra documents are generally not available at the meeting.

4.0 Review minutes of previous meeting

The minutes of the June 6th, 2001, HIPPI Working Meeting in Minneapolis, MN were reviewed.

There were no changes or corrections.

Sean Murphy moved and Roger Ronald seconded, to approve the June working meeting minutes as written.

The motion passed without objection.

The minutes of the August 8th, 2001, HIPPI Working Meeting on the Big Island of Hawaii were reviewed.

There were a few punctuation and grammer changes.

Sean Murphy moved and Roger Ronald seconded, to approve the August working meeting minutes as corrected.

The motion passed without objection.

5.0 Review old action items

The action items from the August 8th, 2001, HIPPI Working Meeting on the Big Island of Hawaii were reviewed.

1. Don Woelz to suggest comment resolutions for SST. (**carryover**)
2. The Chair (Roger Ronald) to produce the minutes for the August, 2001 meeting. (**done**)
3. Sean Murphy to update the HIPPI-6400 HARP document and send it to the IETF. (**done**)

6.0 HIPPI-6400-PH (ref: Rev 2.9)

6.1 Status of Document

T11.1 voted the document forward to T11 for further processing at the April meeting. At the April T11 meeting, Roger Ronald asked that T11 conduct a letter ballot to forward the HIPPI-6400-PH amendment to NCITS for further processing.

The letter ballot was initiated and closed on 6/4/01. The results were 56 for, 0 against, 0 abstentions, and 16 not voting.

There were no substantive comments made against the amendment for HIPPI-6400-PH. T11.1 and T11 voted to send the unchanged document to NCITS for public review and further processing.

Public review for the HIPPI-6400-PH amendment ended on 10/10/01 without any comments being received.

The document has already been edited for ANSI release and I received a copy of the following email:

Dear Don:

I have just completed editing the manuscript of the above standard. Everything is in good order and there are no questions. Your committee even has ANSI's style down pat. We are going right into production.

Please thank your committee for preparing such a useful manuscript. I will keep you posted on its progress.

7.0 SCSI on ST

7.1 Processing Plans

The document was sent to T10 for further processing and a letter ballot. SCSI over ST passed, with a vote result of 34 yes, 1 opposed, 4 abstaining, and 8 not voting.

8 Ballots included comments. There were about 100 comments, most of which were editorial.

7.2 Comment review

No one was present for comment review and resolution, so there is nothing to report on this topic.

8.0 ST API Proposal

SGL provided a new version of the ST API for posting on the web site. This document now provides a view of the SGL implementation of the ST API.

Roger Ronald agreed to investigate whether the VIEO ST API could also be posted to the web site.

9.0 HIPPI-6400 HARP

The group had directed Sean Murphy to proceed with submitting HARP to the IETF.

Sean indicated that he had submitted the document after some back and forth delay with Jean Michael Pettit. The IETF required that the document be submitted as an Internet Draft, but it should move forward to RFC status in a short time.

10.0 Other HIPPI items

None.

11.0 Future meeting schedule

Note that the only meeting anticipated for T11.1 is the December 2001 meeting. At that time, T11.1 will become inactive unless there is new interest in the work of the committee and someone is willing to assume the role of committee chair.
